


As an example of the V6 harmony structure, following is chart for C Major and A Minor. In order to avoid any unresolved Major 7th harmonies, the V6 modifi es chords that contain the 7th tone of the major scales. Therefore for C Major, the 3rd note (E) harmony interval is modifi ed to create a first inversion chord of the tonic (C). Additionally, the 5th note (G) is voiced to present a power 5 chord (G + D without the B), with a suspended 4th (C).
