1. Introduction

This document explains how to install and uninstall the ZOOM UAC-2 Driver.

2. System Requirements

OS : Mac® OS X® 10.8.5 (or later)

CPU: Intel® Core™ i3 or faster

USB: USB 3.0/USB 2.0

(Operation is not guaranteed when used with USB hubs or expansion cards.)

Precautions

1) Start installation and uninstallation disconnecting UAC-2 from Mac

2) Before starting this application, shut down all other applications that are running.

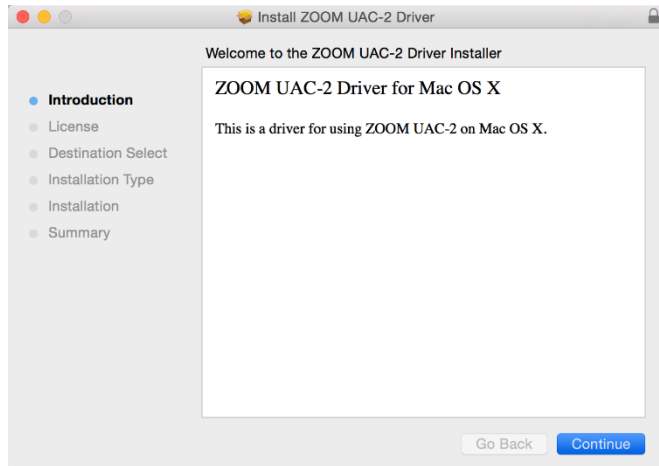
3. Updating the driver

If a ZOOM UAC-2 Driver is already installed, first uninstall the old driver.

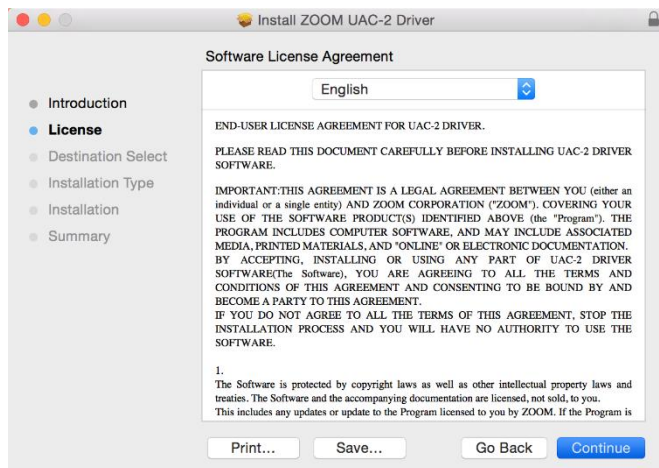
Then install the new driver.

4. Installation

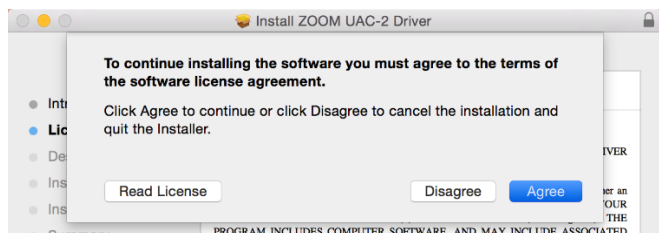
1. Double-click on “ZOOM UAC-2 Driver.pkg”.
2. To start the installation, click [Continue].



3. The License Agreement is displayed. After checking the contents carefully, if you agree to them and will use the software, click [Continue].

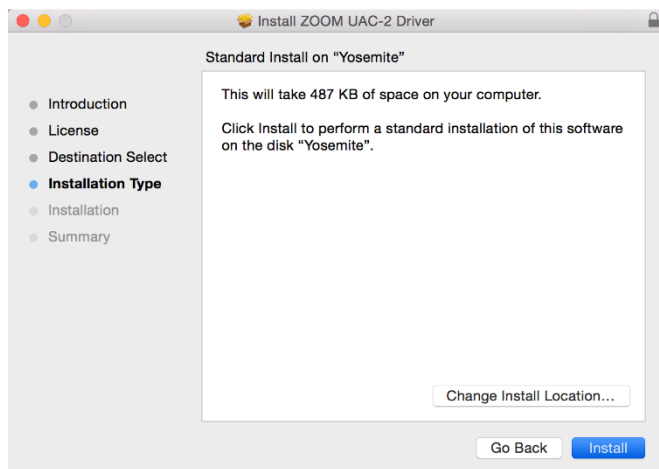


Click [Agree].

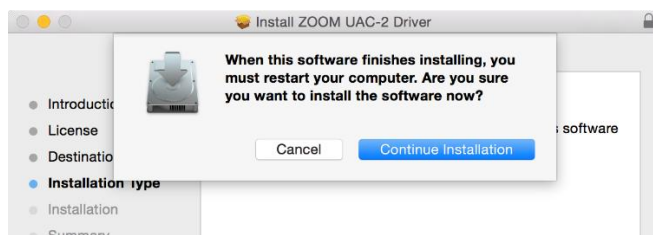


4. To start the installation, click [Install].

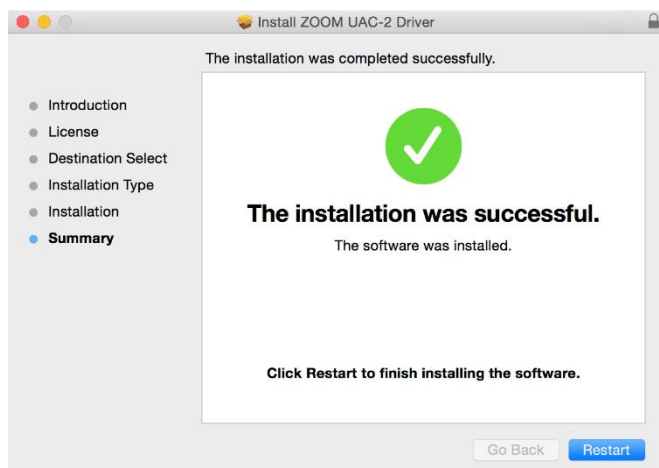
To change the disk where the software is installed, click [Change Install Location...].



After the installation of the driver is complete, the Mac must be restarted. Click [Continue Installation] to install the software.

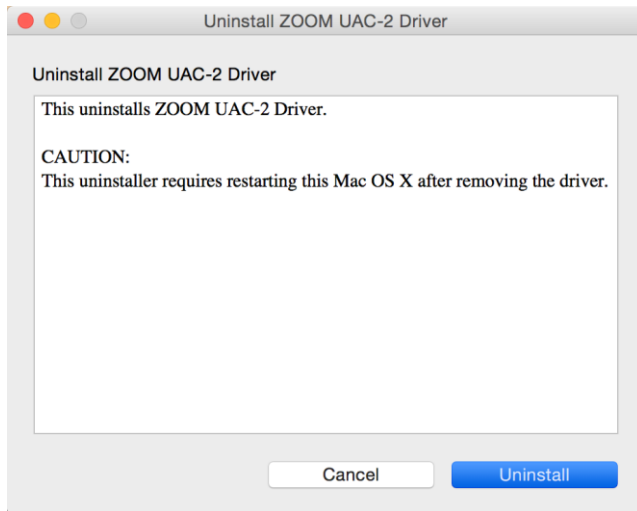


5. After installation completes, click [Restart] to restart the Mac.



5. Uninstallation

1. Double-click on “ZOOM UAC-2 Uninstaller”.
2. The uninstallation process starts. Click [Uninstall] to uninstall the software. After uninstallation, the computer must be restarted.



3. After uninstallation completes, click [Restart] to restart the Mac.
